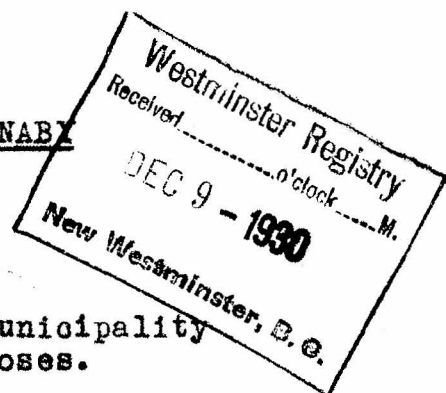


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1196



A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 30 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the lands described in the annexed schedule should be acquired for Corporate purposes.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That the parcel of land set opposite the name of the vendor in the Schedule attached hereto, and hereby incorporated with and made part of this By-law shall be acquired from the person or persons named in the said Schedule, for Corporate purposes.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyance by the said persons named in the said schedule, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, they shall be paid the sum set opposite their respective names in the said Schedule.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY BY-LAW No. 5. 1930."

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this Seventeenth (17th) day of November, A.D. 1930.

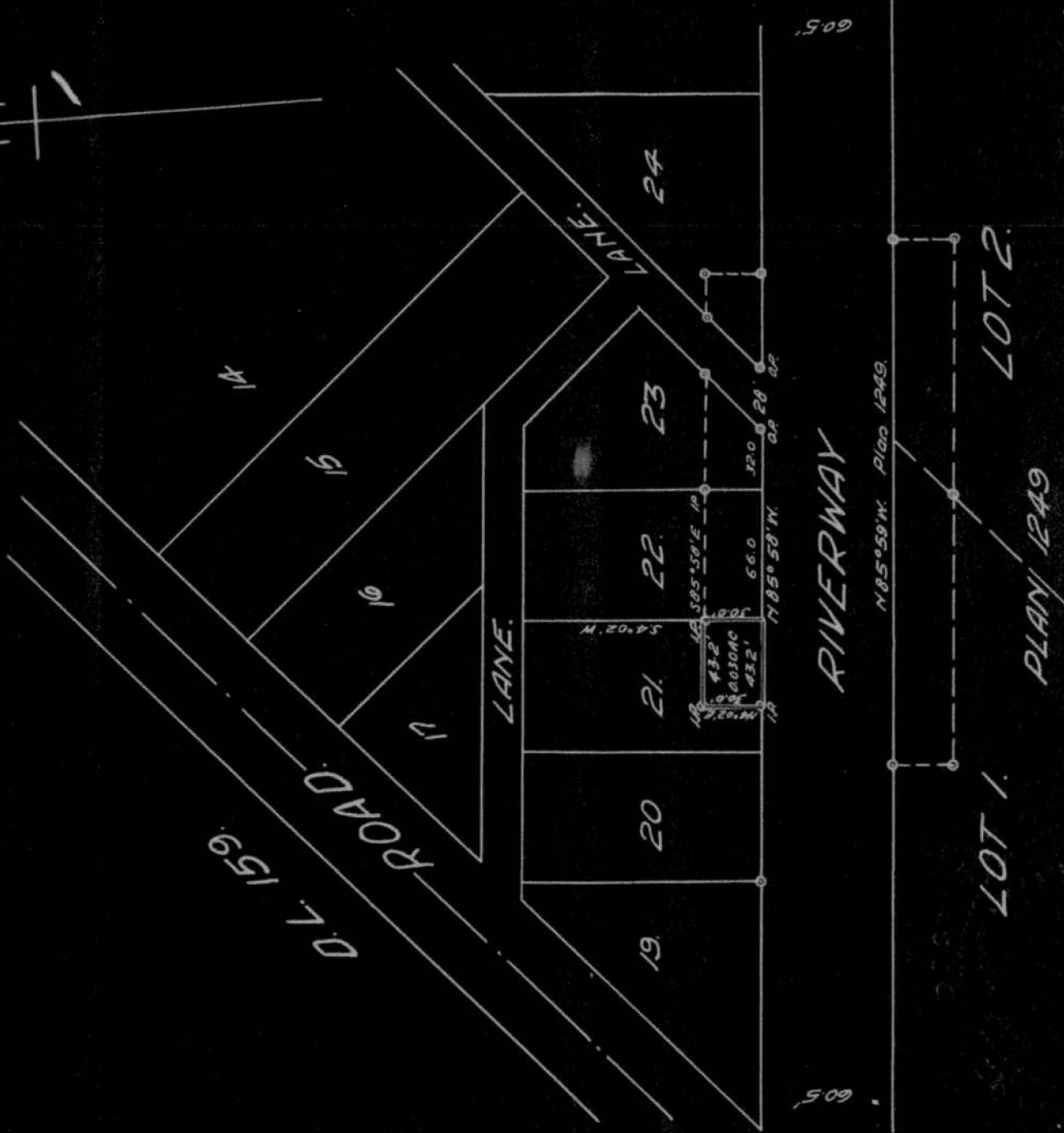
