BY-LAW NO. 1204.

A by-law to authorize the entry upon lands, or premises for the purpose of inspections sewer or water companies of inspections.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

- 1. The word "Engineer" where it occurs in this by-law shall mean the Municipal Engineer for the time being and from time to time of the Corporation and any assistant Engineer of the Corporation or other person authorized by resolution of the Council.
- It shall be lawful for the Engineer together with such workmen as may be necessary to enter upon any lands or premises in the Municipality which may be connected or alleged to be connected with any sewer or water system for the purpose of inspecting any sewer or water connection and in carrying out any such inspection to make any necessary excavation or do any work in or upon the said lands or premises which may be necessary to uncover any such sewer or water connection, provided that after such inspection is completed the said lands and premises shall be restored to the condition in which they were before such work was done.
- 3. Any owner, occupier or other person who prevents, obstructs, delays or interferes with any inspection, excavation or other work mentioned in the preceding section hereof shall be guilty of an infraction of this by-law.
- Any person guilty of an infraction of this by-law or any provision thereof shall upon conviction before the Police Magistrate or any Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction within the municip-

ality, be liable to a penalty not exceeding One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs, and in default of payment forthwith such penalty and costs may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender and in case of there being no distress found out of which the said penalty may be levied, the said Police Magistrate or Justice of the Peace may commit the offender to the common gaol for a term of not more than sixty days.

This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY SEWER AND WATER CONNECTIONS INSPECTION BY-LAW 1930".
