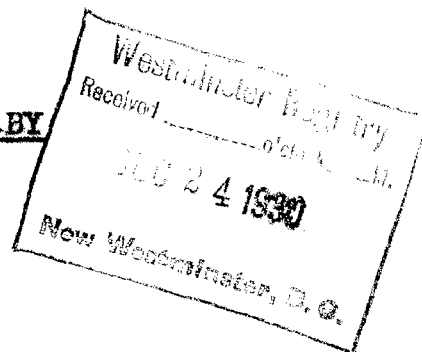


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1206.



A BY-LAW to authorise the construction of a 4' sidewalk on the West side of Gilmore Avenue from Vancouver and Fraser Valley and Southern Railway Company right-of-way to Vancouver, Victoria and Eastern Railway and Navigation Company right-of-way.

WHEREAS Section sub-section 220 of Section 54 of the Municipal Act provides that the Council may by By-law provide for the construction and repair of sidewalks within the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable and expedient that a sidewalk be constructed as hereinafter mentioned.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That a wooden sidewalk four feet wide be constructed upon the West side of Gilmore Avenue from the right of way of the Vancouver, Fraser Valley and Southern Railway Company to the right of way of the Vancouver, Victoria and Eastern Railway and Navigation Company.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "Gilmore Avenue Sidewalk construction By-law 1930."
