

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1262

A BY-LAW to provide for the annual cost of maintaining ornamental street lighting on both sides of Hastings Street between Gilmore Avenue and Earleton Avenue in the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS pursuant to the "District Improvement By-law (Ornamental Lighting) 1931" ornamental lights were installed on the portion of Hastings Street in said by-law described.

AND WHEREAS no provision was made in the said "District Improvement By-law (Ornamental Lighting) 1931" for the extra cost of maintaining said ornamental lighting over and above the cost of the lighting which would ordinarily be supplied to said district at the expense of the Corporation at large.

AND WHEREAS it is provided by Section 53 of the "Local Improvement Act," that:-

- (1) The Council may by-by-law provide that thereafter the annual cost of cleaning, clearing the snow and ice, watering, oiling, tarring, sweeping, lighting, light supplied in excess of that supplied at the expense of the corporation at large, cutting grass and weeds and trimming trees and shrubbery on any street, or any one or more of such services, shall be specially assessed upon the land abutting directly on such street, according to the frontage thereof, and the foregoing provisions of this Act shall not apply to such services.
- (2) Instead of naming the particular street or streets, the by-law may apply to all the streets in a defined section or sections of the municipality.

(3) Where the Council so provides, the amount of the special rate imposed to defray such cost may be entered on the collector's roll and collected in like manner as other taxes.

(4) The By-law shall remain in force from year to year until repealed.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient that the extra cost of maintaining ornamental lights for the district aforesaid over and above the ordinary cost of lighting said district should be paid by said district.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the said Council to levy annually hereafter upon the land abutting directly on both sides of that portion of Hastings Street in the Municipality of Burnaby hereinafter described such an amount per foot frontage over and above the ordinary cost of lighting such portion of Hastings Street as will provide for the cost of maintaining the ornamental lights in said portion of Hastings Street installed pursuant to the "District Improvement By-law (Ornamental Lighting) 1931" and to enter the aforesaid amount per foot frontage upon the Collectors roll and to collect the same in like manner as other taxes.

2. The said portion of Hastings Street hereinbefore mentioned is described as follows:-

"Commencing at the intersection of the lane north of Hastings Street and Gilmore Avenue, thence easterly along the centre line of the lane to its intersection with Carleton Avenue, thence south following the centre line of Carleton Avenue to the intersection of lane south of Hastings Street; thence westerly along the centre line of lane south of Hastings Street, to Gilmore Avenue; thence north along the centre line of Gilmore Avenue to point of commencement."

3. This By-law may be cited as "HASTINGS STREET ORNAMENTAL LIGHTING MAINTANANCE BY-LAW 1931."
