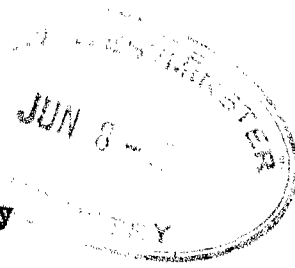


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1275.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 30 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the hereinafter mentioned lands should be acquired for Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS William Henry Tidball and Alice Margaret Cram, wife of William Chester Cram, both of 3267 Kingsway, in the Municipality of Burnaby, are the owners of Lot Eight (8) of District Lot Ninety four (94) Group 1. New Westminster District Map No. 1117.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, being composed of portion of Lot Eight (8) District Lot Ninety four (94) New Westminster District, and which said portion may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at South East corner of said Lot Eight (8), said corner being on Northerly limit of Kingsway;

thence following said limit of Kingsway N 63° 49' W. Thirty six and six tenths feet (36.6);

thence N 5° 23' E. Three hundred and sixty one and two-tenths feet (361.2) more or less, to point of intersection of westerly limit of Denbigh Avenue with northerly boundary of said Lot Eight (8);

thence S. 0° 10' W. Three hundred and seventy five and seventy five hundredths feet (375.75) more or less to point of commencement and containing 0.142 acre more or less as shown colored red on attached plan, Group One (1) Map 1117.

shall be acquired from William Henry Tidball and Alice Margaret Cram, both of 3267 Kingsway, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, for Corporate purposes.

2. On execution and delivery of conveyance by the said William Henry Tidball, Carpenter, and Alice Margaret Cram, wife of William Chester Cram, both of 3267 Kingsway, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, they shall be paid the sum of Eight hundred and fifty (\$850.00) dollars.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Denbigh Avenue Property Purchase By-law 1931".

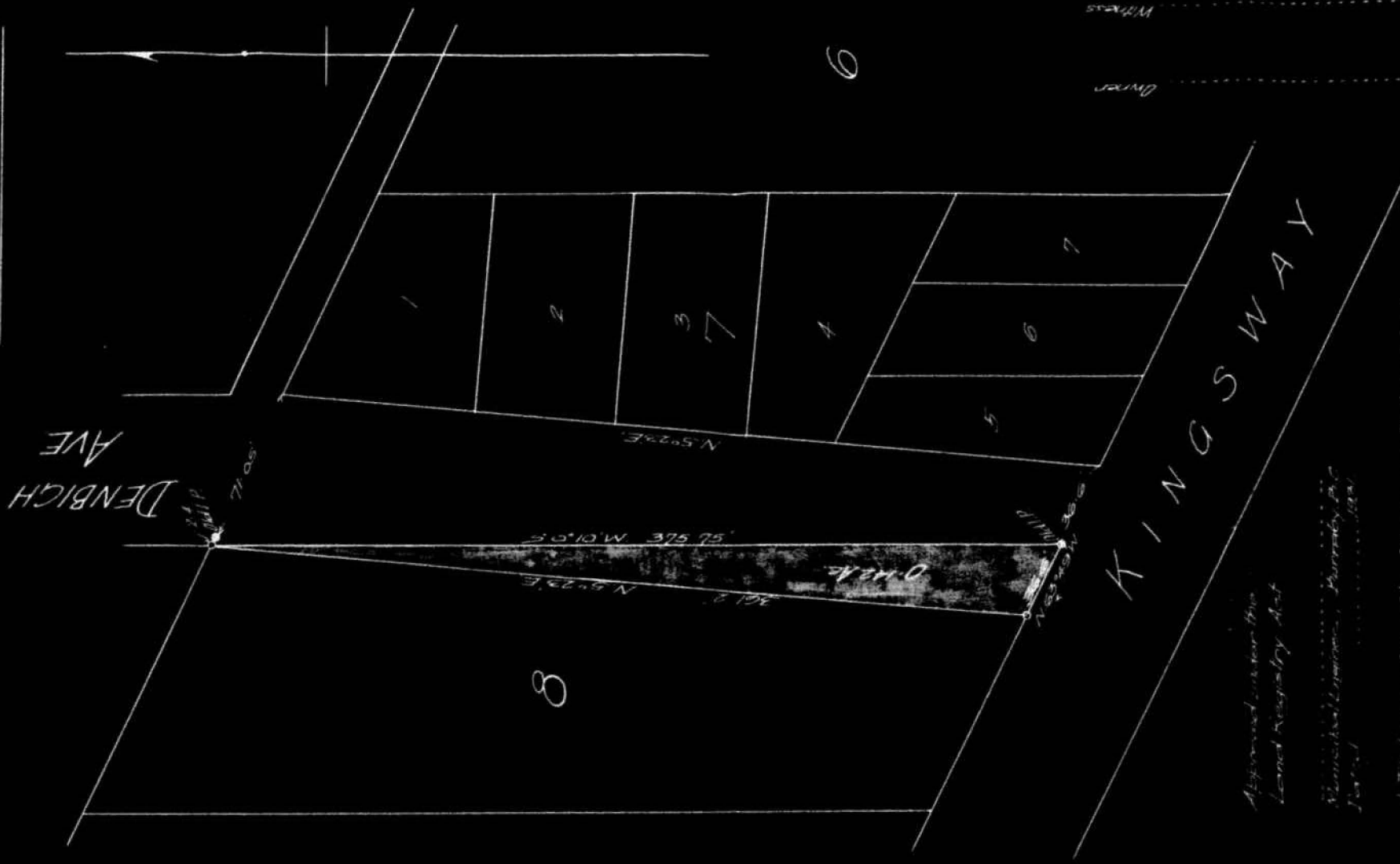
