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## A BY-LAW to authorise the Corporation of the Diatrict of Burnaby to grant an Besement to the Greater Vancouver Fater Distriot.


#### Abstract

WHEREAS the Greater Vanocuver Water District, a Corporation existing under and by virtue of an sot of the Legislature of the Provinoe of British Columbia, is desirous of obteining an easement or right of way over certain lande belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby for the purpose of oonstrueting a


 pipe line through and acroas the said land: AND MHEREAS under the provisions of sub-aection 175 of Section 54, of the Munioipal Aot the Mmicipal Counoil 1s authorised to make and pass a by-law to dispose of lands. AND WHEREAS the Corporetion deem it advisable and In the publio interest to grant such easement.THEREFORE the Manicipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burneby RNACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawrul for the Munioipal Counoil of the Corporation of the pistriot of Burnaby to grant unto the Greater Vancouver Water Distriot, its suceessors and assigns, full and free right and liberty to enter upon and construot, maintain, and use a pipe line through and across gaid hereinafter desoribed property and for that purpose to make exoavations and construet works thereon and to reoeive in payment therefor the sum of One(\$2.00) Dollar.

ALL AND SINGULAR that oertain parcel or traot of land situate, lying and being in the District of Now Festminster in the Provinoe of British Columbia and being composed of portion of Blooks Twenty eight (28) and Twenty nine (29), Distriot Lot Sinety-five (98) Group One (1) in said District, said parcel being twenty (20) feet in width, lying Ten (10) feet on ach side of the following deaeribed centre ine, that is to say:-
