BY-LAW NO. 1333.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 30 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient to acquire the hereinafter described lands for road purposes:

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. A portion of Block Six (6), in the subdivision of a portion of District Lot Eighty seven (87), Group One (1), District of New Westminister, Province of British Columbia, according to Plan Number 966, deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminister, B. C. and being more particularly described as follows:-

Commencing at the Southwest corner of a 3.21 acre portion of Block Six (6) aforesaid, heretofore conveyed and shown on Sketch number 1312 deposited;
thence N 81° 34' W. and following the Northerly Boundary of the Right-of-way of the Vancouver, Fraser Valley and Southern Railway, 20.85 feet to an intersection with the Northwesterly Boundary of Block 6, aforesaid;
thence N 52° 26' E. and following the said Northwesterly Boundary of Block 6, 139.0 feet to an iron pin
thence S 81° 34' E. and parallel to the aforesaid Railway Right-of-way, 20.85 feet to an iron pin set on the Northwesterly Boundary of the 3.21 acre portion of Block 6, aforesaid:
thence S. 52° 26' W. and following the Northwesterly Boundary of said 3.21 acre portion, 139.0 feet to the point of commencement and containing by admeasurement 0.048 of an acre, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon surrounded with red colour, shall be acquired from Arthur R. E. Rowe of 3025 - 6th. Street in the Municipality of Burnaby.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyance by said Arthur R. E. Rowe, of 3025 - 6th. Street, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, he shall be paid the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

4. This By-law may be cited as "ROWE PROPERTY ACQUISITION BY-LAW, 1931."

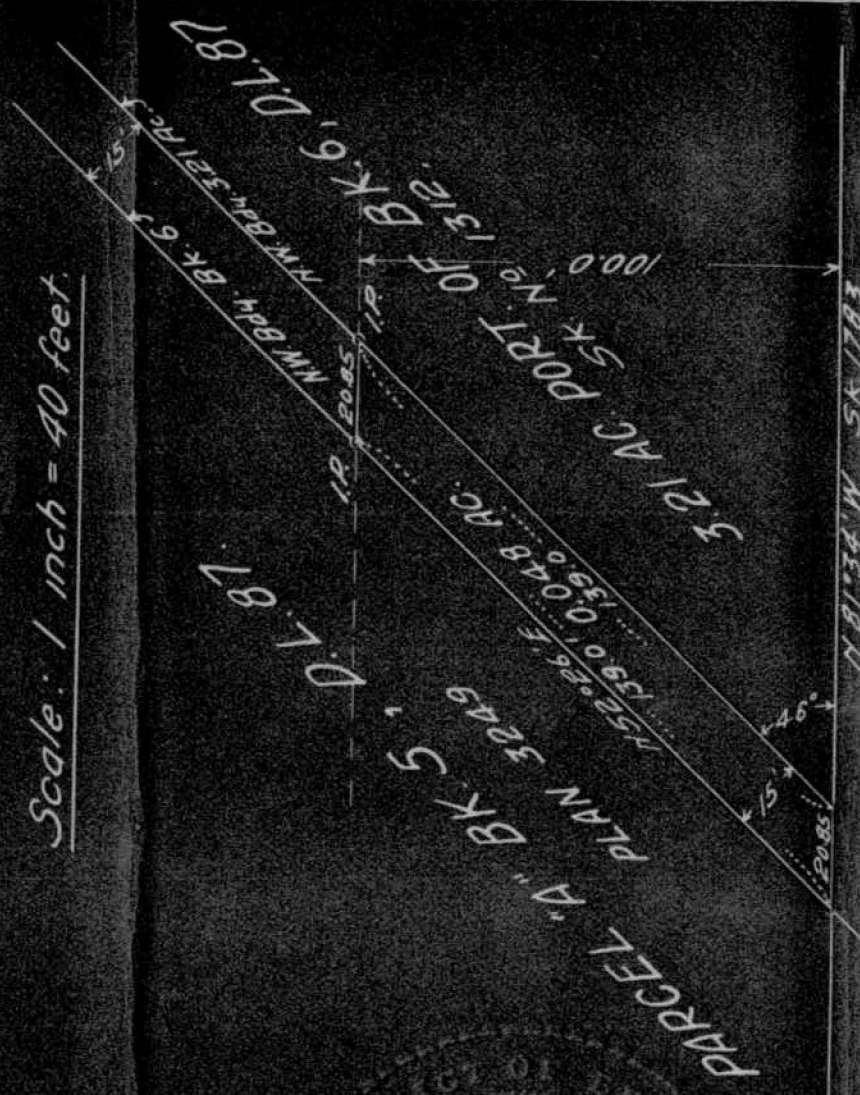
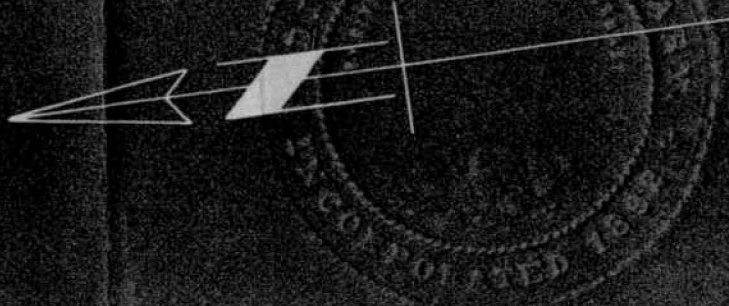
