A BY-LAW to dedicate certain street allowances within the Municipality of Burnaby. REGIS

whereas under the provisions of sub-section 212 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" being Chapter 179 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1924, the Municipal Council is authorised to make By-laws for establishing, opening, making preserving, improving, repairing, widening, altering, diverting or stopping up roads, streets, squares, alleys, lanes, bridges or other public thoroughfares.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that certain lands should be dedicated for the purpose of street allowances in the Municipality of Burnaby.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

- 1. That the following parcels of land, all in Group One (1) New Westminster District, shall be and are hereby dedicated for street purposes, that is to say:-
- (a) Lot Five (5) of Block Thirty-nine (39), of District Lot (34), Map Number 2801.
- (b) Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Subdivision "B" of Block "A", of District Lot Twenty-eight Central, Map N. 1078.
- (c) Lots Kleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Mubdivision "C" of Block "A", of District Lot Twenty-eight (28) Central, Map No. 1078.
- (d) Lot Eleven (ll) of Subdivision "D", of Block "A" of District Lot Twenty eight (28) Central, Map No. 1078.
- (e) Part Forty eight one thousandths (0.048) of an acre more or less of Block Six (6) of Lot Eighty seven (87) Group One (1) Map Nine hundred and sixty six (966) as shewn and outlined in Red colour on Sketch deposited No. Seven thousand two hundred and ninety two (7292)
- 3. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY STREET DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1931."
