CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW MO. 1367.

WESTWINE TELL

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of storm water sewer in certain streets and lanes in the area known as West Burnaby Storm Sewer area in the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS subsection 200 of Section 54 of the Municipal Act provides that the Council may pass by-laws for constructing sewers within the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient in the Public interest to construct sewers as hereinafter provided.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:

1. That storm water sewers be constructed in the following streets and lanes in the Municipality of Burnaby, viz:

Maxwell Street from Boundary Road to Lot 17, Blocks 14,18,19,20, District Lot 35. Through Lots 17,18,19,20, Blocks 14,18,19,20, District Lot 35, and Block 21, District Lot 35 from Maxwell Street to Smith Avenue. Bond Street from Smith Avenue to Inman Avenue. through Block 21, Block 35, from North property line of Lot 20, Blocks 14,18,19 and 20, District Lot 35, at point 176.1 feet west of west property line of Smith Avenue to Smith Avenue at point 144.8 feet north of South property line of Block 21, District Lot 35.

- 2. The work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of the Municipal Engineer.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as "WEST BURNABY STORM SEWER CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW 1932."
