CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY MARKETER THAT BY-LAW NO. 1368

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of combined storm water and sanitary sewers in certain streets and lanes in the area known as Glen Brook Sewer area in the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS subsection 200 of Section 54 of the Municipal Act provides that the Council may pass by-laws for constructing sewers within the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient in the Public interest to construct sewers as hereinafter provided.

AND WHEREAS plans of the proposed sewers have been prepared and were approved by the Provincial Board of Health on the 1st. day of October, 1931.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:

1. That combined storm water and sanitary sewers be constructed in the following streets and lanes in the Municipality of Burnaby, viz:

Eleventh Avenue from Sixth Street to Hilda Street Hilda Street, from Eleventh Avenue to 100' north-westerly.
Sixth Street, from Eleventh Avenue to Nineteenth Avenue.

all in accord with the plans and specifications approved by the Provincial Board of Health on the 1st. day of October, A.D. 1931.

- 2. The work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of the Municipal Engineer.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as "GLENBROOK SEWER CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW 1932."
