

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1423.

A BY-LAW to further amend Burnaby Building
By-law 1926,

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the
District of Burnaby, enacts as follows:-

1. Section 135 of By-law Number 540 of the Corporation
of the District of Burnaby, intituled "Burnaby Building
By-law 1926" as amended by By-law Number 940, is hereby
further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:-

"AND ALSO provided that the Building Inspector may,
in his discretion issue a permit for a metal
chimney commonly known as "Yukon Chimney" of approved
design, for use in one-storey frame buildings, and
further provided that the Building Inspector may
at any time revoke such permit by serving upon the
owner, agent or occupier of any building in which
such chimney is installed, an order in writing to
that effect whereupon such owner, agent, or occupier
shall remove or cause to be removed such metal
chimney, and if the owner, agent, or occupier
refuses or neglects to comply with the order,
directions and conditions of the said order within
the time specified, such owner, agent or occupier
shall be guilty of an infraction of this By-law."

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUILDING
BY-LAW 1926, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1932."
