CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

EY-LAW NO. 1458.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Corporation of the District of Burnaby for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS one John H. Walsh is the owner of land in the Municipality of Burnaby described as the Westerly part of Lot Four (4) Block Eighty two (82) District Lot One hundred and twenty seven (127) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 4953.

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable and expedient that the said land should be acquired by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby for Corporate purposes.

THEREFORE the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That part of Lot Four (4) Block Eighty two (82) District Lot One hundred and twenty seven (127) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 4953, save and except the eastern part of said lot as conveyed and shewn on Sketch No. 7386 deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, shall be acquired from John Henry Walsh.
- 2. That upon delivery to the Corporation by the said John Henry Walsh of a good and sufficient deed of the said lands free and clear of all encumbrance he be paid the sum of Two hundreds and twenty five dollars and eleven cents (\$225.11).
- 3. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Acquisition of Property By-law No. 3. 1933"
