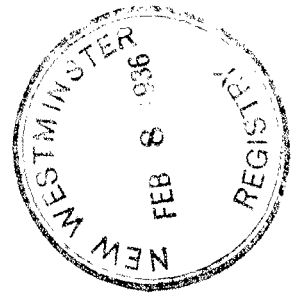


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1543.



A BY-LAW to authorize the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to accept the sum of Three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) in full payment of taxes on Block fifty-nine (59), District Lot Ninety eight (98) up to December thirty-first (31st.) 1935.

WHEREAS by Order in Council No. 1519 approved on the ¹⁹³⁵ twenty-seventh (27th) day of December, power is given to the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to adjust and settle all delinquent taxes and taxes in arrears owing by Dorothy Hornby Taylor, up to the Thirty-first (31st) day of December 1935 amounting to Four hundred and thirty-four dollars and fifty eight cents (\$434.58) upon the lands and premises described as Block Fifty-nine (59), District Lot Ninety eight (98), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 573 in the Municipality of Burnaby and the improvements thereon for the sum of ~~Three~~ hundred and fifty (\$350.00) dollars. *CPB*

THEREFORE the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby Enacts as follows:

1. That the Collector for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby be and is hereby authorized to accept from Dorothy Hornby Taylor, the sum of Three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) in full settlement of all delinquent taxes and taxes in arrears owing by her up to the thirty-first (31st) day of December 1935 upon the lands and premises described as Block Fifty-nine (59) District Lot Ninety-eight (98), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 573 in the Municipality of Burnaby and the Improvements thereon, and to deliver to the said Dorothy Hornby Taylor a receipt in full for the said Taxes.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Taylor Tax Adjustment By-law 1936."
