

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1548.

A By-Law to amend the Burnaby Building
By-law 1926.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926".

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby has power under the Municipal Act being Chapter 179 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1924 and amending acts to pass such by-laws as might be passed by the Council of the Municipality.

THEREFORE the Commissioner of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in exercise of all the powers him thereunto enabling enacts as follows:-

1. Sections 341 to 349 inclusive of the Burnaby Building By-law 1926 are hereby repealed.

2. There shall be inserted as section 341 of the said by-law the following:-

341. In the event of there being any repugnancy between the terms and provisions of this By-law on the one hand and the terms and provisions of the Fire Marshal Act of the Province of British Columbia and/or any regulations made thereunder governing the approval, sale, installation, and maintenance of oil burners and oil burning equipment and appliances using inflammable liquids as fuel or in any amendment or amendments to the said act or said regulations on the other hand, the terms and provisions of the said act and/or the said regulations or any amendment or amendments thereto shall prevail.

3. There shall be inserted as section 342 of the said by-law the following:-

342. In Conformity with the regulations governing the approval sale, installation and maintenance of oil-burners and oil-burning equipment pursuant to the Fire Marshall Act the



Building Inspector of the District of Burnaby is appointed as the Municipal Officer to exercise within the Municipality of Burnaby the powers vested in an officer under the said Regulations.

4. There shall be inserted as Section 343 of the said by-law the following:-

343. No permit required by the said regulations referred to in section 341 hereof shall be issued to any applicant for the installation of any oil-burner or oil-burning equipment until the permit fees and inspection charges levied by this by-law have been paid, and all such fees and charges shall be paid to and collected by the Building Inspector of Burnaby for use of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, at the time of issuing the permit.

5. There shall be inserted as Section 344 of the said by-law the following:-

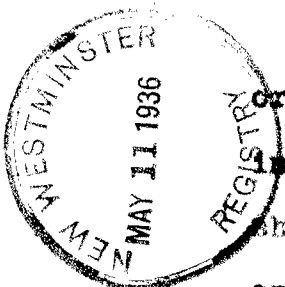
344. Notwithstanding the terms of section 29 hereof, there are hereby levied upon and there shall be paid by every applicant for a permit to instal any oil-burner or oil-burning equipment in the District of Burnaby the following fees and charges namely:

(a) For installation of a commercial oil burner, and oil burning equipment connected therewith a permit fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) and an inspection charge of Two (\$2.00) dollars.

(b) For installation of a domestic oil burner and oil burning equipment connected therewith a permit fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) and an inspection charge of One dollar (\$1.00)

(c) For the installation of a range oil burner and oil burning equipment connected therewith, a permit fee of Fifty cents (\$.50) and an inspection charge of seventy five cents (\$.75)

(d) For all inspections required after the first inspection, or for examining corrections or errors in any of the foregoing inspections, the applicant for the permit shall be charged and shall pay at the rate of \$1.50 per hour for the time so occupied, and for any time under one hour at the same rate, except that the minimum charge shall be One dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50).



6. This by-law may be known and cited for all purposes as the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926 Amendment By-law 1936".

PASSED by the Commissioner of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby on the Fourth (4th) day of March, 1936.

RECONSIDERED, FINALLY ADOPTED AND PASSED by the Commissioner, signed by him and the Municipal Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby on the Eleventh (11th) day of March, 1936.
