## CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BY-LAW No. 1549

A By-law authorizing the Corporation of the District of Burn to raise the Sum of \$15,000.00 Dollars by Way of Loan for Unemployment Relief.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the "Unemployment Relief Act, 1933," being chapter 71 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1933, and amendments thereto, the Corporation is authorized, without obtaining the approval of the electors, to enter into any agreement with the Province of British Columbia which the Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized to enter into under the said Act, and to borrow from the Province any moneys necessary to meet the cost of any relief within the scope of any agreement entered into by the Corporation under the said Act, and to issue to the Province such Treasury notes for the evidencing and repayment of the moneys so borrowed on such terms as to interest, renewals, and otherwise as the Province may require, which Treasury

notes shall be binding upon and payable by the Corporation:	
AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to enter into such an agreement with the Province as	
aforesaid for the purpose of borrowing from the Province the sum of	
Fifteen thousand & 00/100	
Dollars (\$.15,000.00) to meet the cost of direct relief within the Municipality and to issue to the Province a Treasury note to secure the repayment of same on the terms hereinafter stated:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the District
