

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1552.

A BY-LAW to provide for the reduction of
sinking-fund levies in 1936.

THE COMMISSIONER for the Corporation of the District
of Burnaby, with the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities,
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. It is hereby provided that in the year 1936 it shall
not be necessary to levy or raise or provide the sums of money
required by by-laws of the Municipality to the provided for
sinking fund purposes.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SINKING FUND
SUSPENSION BY-LAW 1936."
