

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1555.

A BY-LAW providing for rebate on penalties and interest on taxes in 1936.

THE COMMISSIONER for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That the owner of any land, and improvements (if any) thereon, on which taxes are delinquent or in arrear shall during the year 1936 be entitled, upon payment of the taxes at any time prior to the date of the tax sale in the year 1936, to receive a rebate or allowance of an amount being one-half of the total of all percentages added under Section 241 and of one-half of all interest added under section 243 of the Municipal Act.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PERCENTAGE REBATE BY-LAW 1936."
