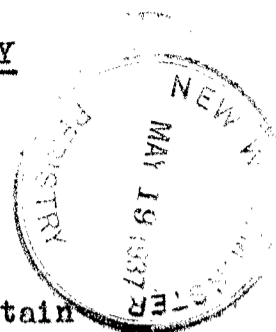


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1589.



A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain Tax Sale lands belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS at the Tax Sale held by the Collector of Burnaby for the year 1934 lands described as Lot One (1), Block "C", District Lot Ninety four central (94C), Group One (1), New Westminister District, Map No. 5895, became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS Margaret Johnson (Widow) of 3412 Kingsway, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, has offered to purchase Lot One (1), Block "C", District Lot Ninety four Central (94C) Group One (1), New Westminister District, Mpp. 5895, for the sum of Three thousand one hundred five dollars (\$3105.00):

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable to accept the said offer:

THE COMMISSIONER for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore enacts as follows:

1. That Lot One (1), Block "C", District Lot Ninety four central (94C), Group One (1), Map No. 5895, New Westminister District, be sold and disposed of to Margaret Johnson for the sum of Three thousand one hundred five dollars (\$3,105.00)

2. That upon payment of the said sum of Three thousand one hundred five dollars, conveyance to the said Margaret Johnson be executed under the seal of the Corporation by the Commissioner and the Clerk and be delivered to the said Margaret Johnson.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW NO. 6, 1937."
