CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1590.

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain Tax Sale lands belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS at the Tax Sale held by the Collector of
Burnaby for the year 1934 lands described as Block Seventeen
(17) District Lot Twenty nine (29) Group One (1) New
Westminster District, Map No. 3478, became the property
of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in default
of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby has caused the said Block Seventeen (17) to be subdivided, and the said subdivision plan has been deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster as Plan No. 5889.

AND WHEREAS the Westminster Hog Fuels Limited a body
Corporate having its head office at the Pacific Coast Terminal
Building, Columbia Street, in the City of New Westminster,
Province of British Columbia, has offered to purchase Lot
One (1) of subdivision of said Block Seventeen (17) District
Lot Twenty-nine (29) Map No. 5889, for the sum of One thousand
(\$1,000.00) Dollars:

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable to accept the said offer:

THE COMMISSIONER for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby THER FORE ENACTS as follows:

1. That Lot One (1) of subdivision of Block Seventeen (17) of District Lot Twenty nine (29) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 5889, be sold and disposed of to the Westminster Hog Fuels Limited for the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars.

- That upon payment of the said sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars, conveyance to the said Westminster Hog Fuels Limited be executed under the seal of the Corporation by the Commissioner and the Clark and be delivered to the said Westminster Hog Fuels Limited.
- This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW NO. 4. 1937.
