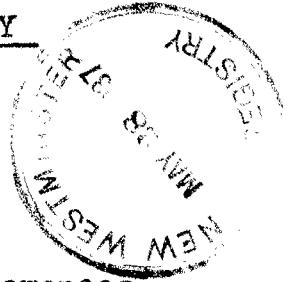


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1594.



A BY-LAW to dedicate certain street allowances within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 212 of Section 54 of the Municipal Act being Chapter 179 Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1924, the Municipal Council is authorised to make by-laws for establishing, opening, making, preserving, improving, repairing, widening, altering, diverting or stopping up roads, streets, squares, alleys, lanes, bridges or other public thoroughfares.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that certain lands should be dedicated for the purpose of street allowances in the Municipality of Burnaby.

THEREFORE the Commissioner of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That the following parcels of land, all in Group One (1) New Westminster District, shall be and are hereby dedicated for street purposes, that is to say:-

(a) The North Twelve feet of Block Thirty nine (39) of Lots One hundred and fifty one, One hundred and fifty two, and One hundred and fifty three (151/3/ Map No. 783 save and except two portions thereof containing the northwesterly 33 feet and the south easterly 23 feet thereof, heretofore conveyed and shewn red and green respectively on Sketch No. 3289.

(b) 0.168 acre portion of Lot 4, of subdivision of Block 22, District Lot 97, as shewn outlined in red on sketch attached hereto, and more particularly described as follows, viz:-

COMMENCING at the Northwest corner of Lot 4, aforesaid; thence Southeastwardly and following the Northeasterly Boundary of said Lot 4 and Southwesterly Boundary of the Right-of-way of the British Columbia Electric Railway, 221.43 feet to the Northeast corner of said Lot;

thence S. 0 degrees 17' E. and following the East Boundary of said Lot 4, 38.76 feet to an iron pin;

thence on a curved line left, drawn with a radius of 2806.9 feet from a tangent bearing N. 58 degrees 24' 20" W., 222.22 feet to an iron pin set on the West Boundary of said Lot 4, at a point 37.2 feet, S 0 degrees 04' 30" E., from the Northwest corner thereof;

thence N. 0 degrees 04' 30" W, 37.2 feet to the point of commencement and containing, by admeasurement, 0.168 of an acre, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour.

(c) 0.125 acre portion of District Lot eighty five (85) as outlined in orange on sketch deposited 19606E.

(d) The north 33 feet of Lots six (6) and Seven (7) of Block 14, District Lot Seventy nine (79) Map No. 536 shown coloured red on sketch deposited No. 2299.

(e) All that portion of the west thirty three feet (33) of Lot One (1) lying between the north boundary of said Lot One (1) and the north boundary of the 2.63 acre part shewn on sketch 6379, in Block 10, District Lot 136, Map No. 3053.

(f) The East 20 feet of Block 51, District Lot 157, Map No. 612 save and except the south 33 feet thereof.

(g) The south six (6) feet of Lot 12, Sd. 5, Block 5, District Lot 206, Map No. 1323.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET DEDICATION BY-LAW 1937."

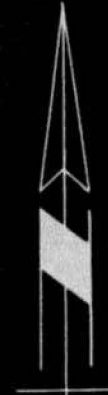
