

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1597

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain tax sale land belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS at the Tax Sale held by the Collector of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby for the year 1934, the lands described as Lot "K" of Block "J" of District Lot Ninety six (96) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 4109, became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in default of other purchaser

AND WHEREAS J. A. MacDonald, of 5275 Rupert Street, in the City of Vancouver, has offered to purchase the said lands for the sum of One thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable to accept the said offer.

THE COMMISSIONER for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby THEREFORE enacts as follows:

1. That Lot "K" of Block "J" of District Lot Ninety six (96) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 4109, be sold and disposed of to J. A. MacDonald, of 5275 Rupert Street, in the City of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia, for the sum of One thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars.

2. That upon payment of the said sum of One thousand (\$1000.) Dollars conveyance to the said J. A. MacDonald be executed under the seal of the Corporation by the Commissioner and the Clerk and be delivered to the said J. A. MacDonald.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND SALE BY-LAW NO. 10. 1937".
