CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1629



A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain Tax Sale lands belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS at the Tax Sale held by the Collector of Burnaby for the year 1919, the lands described as Block "D" of District Lot numbered One hundred and sixty four (164), Group One (1), Map No. 3596 in the District of New Westminster, beceme the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS His Majesty the King in the right of the Frovince of British Columbia has offered to purchase the said lands for the sum of Three thousand five hundred and seventy eight dollars and seventy five cents (\$3578.75).

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable to accept the said offer.

THE COMMISSIONER for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby THEREFORE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Block "D" of District Lot numbered One hundred and sixty four (164), Group One (1), Map No. 3596 in the District of New Westminster, Municipality of Burnaby, be sold and disposed of to His Majesty the King in the right of the Province of British Columbia, for the sum of Three thousand five hundred and seventy eight dollars and seventy five cents (\$3578.75).

2. That upon payment of the said sum of Three thousand five hundred and seventy eight dollars and seventy five cents (\$3578.75) conveyance to the said His Majesty the King in the right of the Province of British Columbia be executed under the Seal of the Corporation by the Commissioner and the Clerk and be delivered to the Minister of Finance of the Province of British Columbia.
