

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 1655

A Bylaw to authorize the Corporation to accept a Quit Claim Deed of the lands and lands covered by water known as Lots "B" and "D" in front of District Lot 213, in the Municipality of Burnaby by Everett Trust and Savings Bank in favour of the Corporation for and to its use.

WHEREAS by virtue of Section 39, subsection 17 (a) of the "Municipal Act" Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1936 and Amending Acts the Council of a Municipality may make bylaws for purchasing, acquiring, leasing or accepting lands, rights, easements or privileges from the Dominion or Provincial Government or from any person for and to the use of the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner of the Municipality of Burnaby has power, under the said Statute, to pass such Bylaws as might be passed by a Council of the said Municipality;

AND WHEREAS the said Commissioner deems it advisable or expedient to accept the lands and lands covered by water hereinafter particularly described and consisting of two separate parcels from the Everett Trust and Savings Bank for and to the use of the Municipality of Burnaby;

THEREFORE the said Commissioner in exercise of all the powers him thereunto enabling enacts as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, and the said Corporation is hereby authorized to accept from the Everett Trust and Savings Bank a Quit Claim Deed granted and duly executed

by it to and in favour of the Corporation of the lands and lands covered by water situated, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as the lands and lands covered by water in Burrard Inlet in front of Lot 213, Group One, New Westminster District, known as Lots "B" and "D" as shown on map deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster under No. 6252.

2. It shall be lawful for the said Corporation and it is hereby authorized, upon delivery to it of the said Quit Claim Deed duly executed as aforesaid, to register the same on its own behalf in the said Land Registry Office so that the title to the said lands and lands covered by water may vest in and be in the name of the said Corporation for and to the use of the said Municipality of Burnaby.

3. That it shall be lawful for the said Corporation and it is hereby authorized to accept and register such other assurances, if any, as may be necessarily granted for the purpose of effectively transferring title to the said lands and lands covered by water from the said Everett Trust and Savings Bank to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby for and to its use.

4. This Bylaw shall not come into force and effect unless and until it has received the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council as required by law.

5. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY ACCEPTANCE OF LANDS BYLAW 1939".
