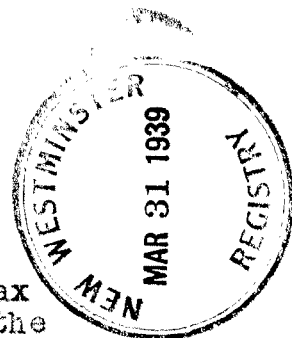


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1660.



A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain Tax Sale lands belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, and to accept in part or full payment therefor other lands in the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Corporation has acquired under Tax Sale proceedings, lands and premises described in Column One of the Schedule hereto annexed.

AND WHEREAS the persons named in the Second Column of the Schedule hereto annexed are the owners of land and premises described in Column Three of the said Schedule.

AND WHEREAS the said parties have requested the Corporation to convey to them the lands set opposite their respective names in said column one and to accept in full payment therefor, conveyances of the lands and premises set opposite their respective names in said Column Three together with the sums set forth in Column Four of the said Schedule.

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it expedient to effect such exchange of lands.

THE COMMISSIONER of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore ENACTS as follows:

1. Upon the execution and delivery to the Corporation by the parties named in the Second Column of the Schedule attached to and forming part of this By-law of a good and sufficient Deed of the lands and premises set opposite their respective names in Column Three of the said Schedule together with the other consideration as set opposite their respective names in Column Four of the said Schedule, free and clear of all encumbrance whatsoever, the Commissioner and Clerk of the Corporation are

hereby authorized and empowered to execute and set the Official and Corporate Seal of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to a Conveyance of the lands set out in Column One of the said Schedule to the persons named opposite the respective parcels in Column Two of the said Schedule, and to deliver such Conveyances when so executed to the said persons.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PROPERTY EXCHANGE BY-LAW NO. 2, 1939."

DONE AND PASSED on the eighth (8th) day of March, A.D. 1939.
