

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1662.

A BY-LAW to provide for the reduction of  
sinking fund levies in 1939.

THE COMMISSIONER for the Corporation of the District  
of Burnaby, with the approval of the Inspector of  
Municipalities, ENACTS as follows:-

1. It is hereby provided that in the year 1939 it  
shall not be necessary to levy or raise or provide the  
sums of money required by by-laws of the municipality  
to be provided for sinking fund purposes.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SINKING  
FUND SUSPENSION BY-LAW 1939."
