

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1699



A BY-LAW to authorise the sale of certain tax sale lands belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, and to accept in part or full payment therefor other lands in the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby has acquired under Tax sale proceedings, lands and premises described as Lot One (1) Block Forty one (41) District Lots One hundred and twenty two (122), One hundred and twenty three (123) and One hundred and twenty four (124) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 1543.

AND WHEREAS Frederick William Mills of 4136 Georgia Street East in the Municipality of Burnaby is the owner of lands and premises described as Lot One (1) Block Forty eight (48) District Lots One hundred and twenty two (122), One hundred and twenty three (123) and One hundred and twenty four (124) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 1543.

AND WHEREAS the said Frederick William Mills has requested the Corporation to convey to him the said lands described as Lot One (1) Block Forty one (41) District Lots One hundred and twenty two (122), One hundred and twenty three (123) and One hundred and twenty four (124) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 1543, and to accept in full payment therefor conveyance of the lands and premises described as Lot One (1) Block Forty eight (48) District Lots One hundred and twenty two (122), One hundred and twenty three (123), and One hundred and twenty four (124) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 1543.

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it expedient to effect such exchange of lands.
