

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1716.



A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of Lot "A", S.D. 3, Block 9, D.L. 34, Group One (1), New Westminster District Map No. 2038 to Willard Hermon Hoyt.

WHEREAS Lot "A", Subdivision of Lot Three (3) of Block Nine (9) of District Lot numbered Thirty four (34), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 2038, in the Municipality of Burnaby became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby under the authorization of By-law No. 541 of the said Corporation for Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS the said lands and premises are no longer required for said Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS Willard Hermon Hoyt, of 4339 Kinnee Street in the Municipality of Burnaby has offered to purchase the said lands and premises and it is deemed expedient to accept the said offer.

AND WHEREAS the value of the said lands and premises does not exceed the sum of Two thousand dollars:

THEREFORE the Commissioner for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That Lot "A", S.D. 3, Block 9, D.L. 34, Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. 2038 be sold to Willard Hermon Hoyt, of the Municipality of Burnaby, for the sum of Four hundred (\$400.00) dollars.

2. That upon payment of the consideration named herein, Conveyance to the purchaser be executed under the seal of the Corporation by the Commissioner and Clerk, and be delivered to the purchaser.

3. This By-law may be cited as "SCOTT PROPERTY SALE BY-LAW 1940."
