

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1721.

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of Lot 4, Block 28, D.L. 172, Group 1. New Westminster District, Map No. 2974, by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.



WHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby acquired Lot 4, Block 28, D.L. 172, Group One (1) Map No. 2974 for Corporate purposes in October, 1926.

AND WHEREAS the said land is no longer required for Corporate purposes,

AND WHEREAS Doris Longstaff of 2235 9th Avenue in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia has offered the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars for the said land.

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable to accept the said offer.

THEREFORE the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That Lot 4, Block 28, D.L. 172. Group 1. New Westminster District, Map No. 2974 be sold and disposed of to Doris Longstaff of 2235 9th Avenue in the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, for the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars, and that upon the payment to the Corporation of the said sum of One hundred and fifty dollars, that the Commissioner and Clerk be authorized to execute and set the Corporate seal to an indenture of conveyance to the said Doris Longstaff.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon the registration thereof.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as
