

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1732.

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of Lot 26, Block 27, D.L. 121, Group 1, New Westminister District in the Municipality of Burnaby to Mrs. D. S. Sculland.



WHEREAS Lot 26, Block 27, D.L. 121, Group 1, Map No. 1054, New Westminister District, was acquired by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in the year 1912, for Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS the said lot is no longer required for Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS Mrs. Doris Amelia Sculland has offered to purchase the said property for the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept the said offer.

NOW THEREFORE the Commissioner for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That Lot 26, Block 27, D.L. 121, Group 1, New Westminister District, Map No. 1054, be sold and disposed of to Doris Amelia Sculland, of 3155 East 8th Avenue in the City of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia, for the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) dollars, and that upon payment to the Corporation of the said sum of One hundred (\$100.00) dollars, that the Commissioner and Clerk be authorized to execute and set the Corporate Seal to an indenture of conveyance to the said Doris Amelia Sculland.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon the registration thereof.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "DISTRICT OF BURNABY CORPORATE LAND SALE BY-LAW, 1941."
