

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1740.

A BY-LAW to dedicate certain street allowances within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 217 of Section 59 of the Municipal Act being chapter 199 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936, the Municipal Council is authorised to make by-laws for establishing, opening, amking, preserving, improving, repairing, widening, altering, diverting, or stopping up roads, streets, squares, alleys, lanes, bridges, or other public thoroughfares.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that certain lands should be dedicated for the purpose of street allowances in the Municipality of Burnaby.

THEREFORE the Commissioner of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That the following parcels of land, all in Group One (1) New Westminster District, shall be and are hereby dedicated for street purposes, that is to say:-

- (a) The West Twenty (20) feet of Lot Thirty-seven (37) of Block Thirteen (13) of District Lot Sixty eight (68) of Map No. 1009.
- (b) The East Five (5) feet of Lot Eleven (11) of Lot Six (6) of Block Four (4) of District Lot Two hundred and six (206) Map No. 1323.
- (c) Lot Ten (10) of Block One (1) of subdivision of District Lots numbered One hundred and fifty one (151); One hundred and fifty two (152) and One hundred and fifty three (153) Map N. 1662.
- (d) The North thirty three (33) feet of Lot Sixteen (16) Block Six (6) subdivision of the south half of District Lot Seventy four (74) Map No. 1380.
- (e) Lot Fifty one (51) of Block Ten (10) of subdivision of District Lot Thirty two (32) Map No. 1166.
- (f) North six (6) feet of Lot Seventeen (17) of subdivision of Blocks Twenty three (23) and Twenty four (24) of District Lot Thirty two (32) Map No. 1444.

(g) The East thirty three (33) feet of the 13.005 acre portion of District Lot Sixty eight (68) colored red on Sketch No. 5054.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Street Dedication By-law 1941."
