

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1741.



A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of part of Lot 8, Group 1. New Westminster District, in the Municipality of Burnaby, to William Copping.

WHEREAS the hereinafter mentioned lands were acquired by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby in the year 1912, for Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS the said described property is no longer required for Corporate purposes:

AND WHEREAS William Copping of the Municipality of Burnaby has offered to purchase the said property for the sum of One hundred and twenty five (\$125.00) dollars.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept the said offer.

NOW THEREFORE the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises lying and being in the District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia and composed of part sixty six (66') feet by One hundred and thirty two (132') feet of Lot Eight (8) Group One (1) as shown and outlined in Orange on Sketch deposited numbered 1628, be sold and disposed of to William Copping of the Municipality of Burnaby Province of British Columbia, for the sum of One hundred and twenty five (\$125.00) dollars, and that upon payment of the said sum of One hundred and twenty five (\$125.00) dollars that the Commissioner and Clerk of the said Corporation be and are hereby authorized to sign and affix the seal of the Corporation to an indenture of conveyance to the said William Copping.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon the registration

thereof.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as
