THE COKPOKATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1772

> A BY-LAW to define and set aside certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Parks purposes.

WHEREAS by paragraph "D" of sub-section 179 of Section 59 of the "Municipal act" it is provided that in evory Municipality the Council may, by By-law finally passed by a three-fourths vote of all the members thereof, and without obtaining the assent of the electors, define an area comprising lands that have become the property of the Municipality through tax sale proceedings and set aside such area for park purposes, for recreation grounds, or school sites, or for other public purposes.

AND WHEREAS the lands shewn on the attached schedule, which schedule is hereby incorporated with and nade part of this By-law, became the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby by virtue of Tax sale Proceedings.

AND WHEREAS the Commissinner for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the powers him thereunto enabling deems it expedient and in the public intorest that the hereinbefore lands should be set aside for parks purnoses.

THEREFOKE, the Commissioner for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENaCTS as follows:

1. The lands as set forth in the schedule attached hereto, which schedule is hereby incorporated with and made part of this By-law, be and are hereby set apart for Park purposes.
2. That the area comprised of the said lands and premises is hereby defined as a Park to be known heroaftor as "Barnet Mountain Park".
3. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon registration thereof.
4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Burnaby Park Dedication By-law 1942".
