

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1775.

A BY-LAW to dedicate and set aside for School purposes, certain lands acquired by The Corporation of the District of Burnaby through Tax Sale proceedings.

WHEREAS the lands and premises hereinafter referred to became the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby at Tax sale in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest that the said lands should be dedicated and set aside for School purposes.

THEREFORE the Commissioner for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. All and singular those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, District of New Westminster, and Province of British Columbia, and composed of Lots "A", Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Sixteen (16), and Nineteen (19), in Block One (1) District Lot One hundred and Twenty two (122), Group One (1), Map No. 1308 be and are hereby dedicated and set aside to and for the use of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby District Municipality School District.

2. This By-law shall come into force upon registration thereof in the manner required by law.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY D.L. 122 SCHOOL PROPERTY BY-LAW 1942."
