## CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BY\_LAW NO. 1776

A BY-LAW to amend "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 5. 1942"

WHEREAS on the 18th day of April, A.D. 1942 one Winnifred M. D. Trembath of 3890 Manor Street, in the Municipality of Burnaby made application to purchase from the Corporation of the District of Burnaby certain lands acquired by the Corporation at Tax sale described as Lot numbered Five (5) of Block numbered Thirty (30) of subdivision of District Lot Sixty nine (69) Group One (1) New Westminster District Map No. 1321, for the sum of Three hundred dollars:

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby by By-law No. 1770 entituled "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 5. 1942" authorised the sale of the said lands to the said Winnigred M. D. Trembath for the sum of Three hundred dollars:

AND WHEREAS the said Winnifred M. D. Trembath has paid to the Corporation an initial payment on account of such purchase in the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) dollars:

AND WHEREAS the said Winnifred M. D. Trembath has advised the Commissioner that she is unable to complete the purchase of the said property:

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner deems it advisable that the sale of the said property to the said Winnifred M. D. Trembath should be cancelled:

THEREFORE the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, ENACTS as follows:

(1) "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 5. 1942" is hereby amended by striking out the following item in the Schedule attached to and forming part of the said By-law:

Lot 5, Block 30 D.L. 69. Map No. 1321 Trembath, Winnifred M. D. 3890 Manor Street, New Westminster \$300.00

(2) This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 5. 1942 Amendment By-law 1942"
