## CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY



## BY-LAW NO. 1780

A BY-LAW to provide for the employment of persons to perform any work in the Municipality upon the condition that the salary or wages payable to such persons shall be applied in payment of taxes due by such persons to the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS paragraph (4) of Section 252 of the "Municipal Act" Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1926 provides that the Council may by By-law provide for the employment of persons to perform any work in the Municipality upon the condition that the salary or wages payable to such persons shall be applied to payment of taxes due by such persons to the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it expedient and advisable to pass such a By-law.

THEREFORE the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. It shall be lawful for the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to enter into arrangements with persons, resident within the Municipality, whereby the said persons may be employed to carry out and perform certain works or duties within the Municipality on condition that the salary or wages payable therefor shall be applied in payment of taxes delinquent in the year 1942 upon property owned and used by the said persons respectively.
- 2. This By-law shall not come into force and effect unless and until it shall have received the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council as provided in Part 23 of the "Municipal Act".

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY DELINQUENT TAXES BY-LAW 1942".
