

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1784.

A BY-LAW authorizing the Commissioner of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to convey the hereinafter described lands to the Board of School Trustees for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS the lands and premises hereinafter referred to became the property of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby at Tax Sale in default of other purchaser.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby under the terms of By-law 1775 dedicated and set aside the hereinafter described lands for school purposes.

AND WHEREAS under sub-section 187 of Section 59 of the "Municipal Act" R.S.B.C. 1935 power is given to a Municipal Council to convey, with the consent of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, to the Board of School Trustees having jurisdiction within the municipality, in trust for school purposes and as school-sites, any lands held or acquired by the municipality for school purposes.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the public interest that the said lands should be conveyed to the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby for school purposes.

THEREFORE the Commissioner for The Corporation of The District of Burnaby, pursuant to the powers him thereunto enabling ENACTS as follows:-

1. That the Corporation of the District of Burnaby be and is hereby authorized to convey to the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby in trust for school purposes and as school sites all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and

described as Lots "A", Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Sixteen (16) and Nineteen (19) in Block numbered One (1) in Subdivision of District Lot numbered One Hundred and Twenty two (122), Group One (1), New Westminster District according to the registered map or plan of the said subdivision deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster in the Province of British Columbia and numbered 1308.

2. THIS BY-LAW shall come into force upon registration thereof in the manner required by law.

3. THIS BY-LAW may be cited as "BURNABY D.L. 122 SCHOOL PROPERTY BY-LAW No. 2, 1942."
