A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of Lot "B" S.D. 2. Block 2. of a subdivision of District Lot 158, Group One (1) New Westminster District Map No. 3423, to Frederick Clifford Olney.

WHEREAS Lot "B" subdivision of Lot Two (2) of Block Two (2) of District Lot One hundred and fifty eight (158) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 3423, in the Municipality of Burnaby became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby under the authorization of By-law No. 505 of the said Corporation for Corporate purposes.

2. That upon payment of the consideration named herein, conveyance to the purchaser be executed under the seal of the Corporation by the Commissioner and Clerk, and be delivered to the purchaser.
