

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1795

A BY-LAW to define and set aside certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Parks purposes.

WHEREAS by paragraph "B" of sub-section 179 of Section 59 of the "Municipal Act" it is provided that in every Municipality the Council may, by By-law finally passed by a three-fourths vote of all the members thereof, and without obtaining the assent of the electors, define an area comprising lands that have become the property of the Municipality through tax sale proceedings and set aside such area for park purposes, for recreation grounds, or school sites, or for other public purposes.

AND WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby by virtue of Tax sale proceedings.

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the powers him thereunto enabling deems it expedient and in the public interest that the hereinafter described lands should be set aside for Park purposes.

THEREFORE, the Commissioner for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There is hereby defined and set apart for park purposes all the lands comprised in the following, viz:

(a) Lots Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14) of subdivision of District Lot numbered Eighty five (85) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map No. 3322. 1905 A

(b) Part One and forty eight one-hundredths (1.48) acres more or less of Lot Eighty five (85) Group One (1) New Westminster District, as shewn and coloured Red on Sketch 2304, save and except 0.48 of an acre shewn on Sketch No. 7689. 1905 A

2. That the area comprised of the said lands and premises is hereby defined as a Park to be known hereafter as "Deer Lake Park".

3. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon registration thereof.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2. 1942"
