CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW No. 1803.

A BY-LAW to amend the Burnaby Building By-law 1926.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 189 of the Burnaby Building By-law 1926, being By-law No. 540 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby as amended by Burnaby Building By-law 1926 Amendment By-law No. 2, 1929, being By-law No. 940 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, is hereby rescinded, and the following substituted therefore
 - "189. In frame buildings bearing walls shall be constructed of 2" x 4" studs at 16" centres, except that in one storey dwellings only, the Building Inspector may approve of 2" x 3" studs at 12" centres, and where the interior finish of such walls is of lumber or other approved wall-board studs of 2" x 4" at 24" centres may be permitted."
- 2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUILDING BY-LAW 1926 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1943."
