

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1808.

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby, for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable and in the public interest that Lot Three (3) of Subdivision of Lot "D", of Block Ten (10) of District Lot One hundred and Seventy one (171) Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1128, should be acquired for Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS one Robert Day, of Kamloops Junction, in the Province of British Columbia, is the owner in fee of the said Lot.

AND WHEREAS the said Robert Day has offered to convey the said Lot to the Corporation for the sum of Two hundred Dollars.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire from Robert Day of Kamloops Junction, in the Province of British Columbia, retired, for Corporate purposes the parcel of land more particularly described as follows, that is to say:

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as Lot Three (3) of Block "D" of Block Ten (10) of Lot One hundred and Seventy one (171) Group One (1), Map No. 1128.

2. Upon execution and delivery of a conveyance by the said Robert Day, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, he shall be paid the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.

3. This By-law may be cited as "ROBERT DAY PROPERTY
PURCHASE BY-LAW 1943."
