## CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 1813.

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of Lot 7, Block 1, D.L. 117 W.1, Group 1. New Westminster District, Map No. 1008 to Agnes Elleanora Davis.

whereas Lot Seven (7) of Block (1) of a subdivision of the Westerly one-half of District Lot One hundred and Seventeen (117 W. 1) Group One (1), Map 1008 in the District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, Municipality of Burnaby became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby under the authorization of By-law 533 of the said Corporation for Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS the said lands and premises are no longer required for said Corporate purposes.

AND WHEREAS Agnes Elleanora Davis, of the Municipality of Burnaby has offered to purchase the said lands and premises and it is deemed expedient to accept the said offer.

AND WHEREAS the value of the said lands and premises does not exceed the sum of Two thousand dollars.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- l. Lot Seven (7) of Block One (1) of a subdivision of the Westerly one-half of District Lot one hundred and Seventeen (117 W. 12) Group One (1) in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, Map No. 1008, be sold to Agnes Elleanora Davis, of 3974 Kitchener Street, in the Municipality of Burnaby, for the sum of Seven hundred (\$700.00) dollars.
- 2. That upon payment of the consideration named herein Conveyance to the purchaser be executed under the Seal of the Corporation by the Reeve and the Clerk and be delivered to the purchaser.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as "M. M. JONES PROPERTY SALE BY-LAW 1943."
