



CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1831

A BY-LAW to amend "Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1928.

WHEREAS by sub-section 8 of Section 59 of the Municipal Act, R.S.B.C. 1936, it is provided that the Council may from time to time make, alter and repeal by-laws for indemnifying the Reeve and Councillors by a sum of money out of the annual revenue to each in respect of their attendance at meetings of the Council and Committees.

AND WHEREAS the said sub-section further provides that the remuneration to Aldermen or Councillors of a Municipality having a population of twenty thousand or more may be at a rate not exceeding One thousand dollars per annum.

AND WHEREAS the population of the Municipality of Burnaby according to the last revised census is 30,352.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. That paragraph (1) of the Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1928, being By-law No. 690 of the Corporation be amended by striking out the words and figures "Five hundred (\$500.00)" where they appear in the fourth line thereof, and that the words and figures "Seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00) dollars" be substituted therefor.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY INDEMNITY BY-LAW 1928 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1944."
