

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1833

A BY-LAW to enable the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to provide for all sums which may be required for the lawful purposes of the Municipality and for School Board purposes, for the year 1944.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to pass a By-law for the above named purposes:

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Act" and Amending Acts and any other act or acts thereunto enabling ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1944 upon the assessed value of all improved taxable land and upon fifty per centum of all taxable improvements in the said Municipality of Burnaby as shown upon the last revised Assessment Roll thereof, a tax of Forty nine (49) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:

(a) to provide, in and for the year 1944, in accordance with the provisions of the "District of Burnaby Debt Refunding Act 1940" (1) the sum of \$90,000.00 for payment in the first place of interest on Refunding Debentures Series "A" issued under the said Act and thereafter, so far as the balance will thereunto extend for the purchase or redemption of the said Debentures: (2) the sum of \$10,000.00 to enable the Corporation to make payment of that amount to the Royal Bank of Canada in part satisfaction of the Corporation's indebtedness to the said Bank: (3) a sum sufficient for payment by the Corporation to the said Bank on and in respect of the said indebtedness, of interest at the rate of $4\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum, payable half yearly on the 2nd day of January and the 2nd day of July, 1943: (4) the sum of \$10,000.00 to enable the Corporation to

make payment of that amount to the Province of British Columbia in partial discharge of the Corporation's indebtedness to the said Province and (5) a sum sufficient for payment by the Corporation to the said Province on and in respect of the said indebtedness, of interest at the rate of $3\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum, nine and two tenths (9.20) mills in the dollar by way of a special rate to be known as the "MUNICIPAL LOAN RATE".

(b) to provide for the general purposes of the Municipality Fourteen and seventy four one hundredths (14.74) mills in the dollar to be called the "GENERAL RATE".

(c) to provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby, Twenty one and three tenths (21.30) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(d) to provide for the payment of the proportion of the estimate for 1943 of the Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board, Three and seventy six one-hundredths (3.76) mills in the dollar to be called the "VANCOUVER AND DISTRICTS JOINT SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE RATE".

2. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1944 upon the assessed value of the land and upon fifty per centum of improvements in the said Municipality of Burnaby as shown upon the last revised Assessment Roll thereof, a tax of Three and one-tenth (3.1) mills in the dollar for the following purpose:

(a) to provide, in and for the year 1944, for the housing maintenance and operation of the Burnaby Fire Department, a tax of Three and one tenth (3.1) mills in the dollar to be called the "FIRE RATE".

3. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1944 upon the frontage of each lot shown upon the special Assessment Roll prepared pursuant to Hastings Street Ornamental Lighting Maintenance By-law 1930 a special rate of Twenty-two (22) cents per front foot to provide for the cost of maintaining ornamental lights installed pursuant to the "District Improvement By-law (Ornamental Lighting) 1929" in that portion of Hastings Street described in the said By-law.

4. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1944 upon the frontage of each lot shown upon the special Assessment Roll prepared pursuant to Hastings Street Ornamental Lighting Maintenance By-law 1931 a special rate of Twenty two (22) cents per front foot to provide for the cost of maintaining ornamental lights installed pursuant to the "District Improvement By-law (Ornamental Lighting) 1931" in that portion of Hastings Street described in the said By-law.

5. The said Taxes and special rates shall be payable to the Collector, at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, of the said Municipality.

6. Provided, however, anything hereinbefore contained to the contrary notwithstanding the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar shall be the minimum taxation upon any parcel of taxable land upon the assessment roll of the Municipality.

7. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY REVENUE BY-LAW 1944."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council the Third (3rd) day of April, A.D. 1944.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by a three-fourths majority of all the members of the Municipal Council on the Eleventh (11th) day of April, A.D. 1944.
