

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1836.

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 699 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Paragraph (7) of the "Burnaby Subdivision Plan Approval By-law, 1928 is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

7. All lots in any subdivision shall have a minimum frontage of Fifty feet and a minimum depth of One hundred feet, but always provided that no lot shall be of an area containing less than six thousand (6000) square feet, and further provided that the foregoing provisions shall not apply to any subdivision within a Commercial area as defined by any Town Planning By-law of the Corporation, but the size of the lots in any such subdivision shall be subject to the approval of the Council.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY SUBDIVISION PLAN APPROVAL BY-LAW, 1928 AMENDMENT BY-LAW, 1944."
