

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1848.

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926"

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS follows:-

1. Burnaby Building By-law 1926 being By-law No. 540 of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby amended by adding as Section 303 (a) the following:-

"303A - Except that such walls or any part thereof may, when approval therefor is given in writing by the Building Inspector, be of frame construction with an external covering of one layer of lumber not less than three quarters of an inch ($\frac{3}{4}$ ") in thickness with cement rendered stucco on metal lath not less than one-half inch ($\frac{1}{2}$ ") in thickness thereon as the outside finish thereof, and an internal covering of one layer of lumber not less than three-quarters of an inch ($\frac{3}{4}$ ") in thickness with gypsum or equivalent lath not less than three-eighths ($\frac{3}{8}$ th in) of an inch in thickness thereon, such lath to be plastered with hard wall plaster not less than three eights ($\frac{3}{8}$ th) inch in thickness.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUILDING BY-LAW 1926 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1944."
