

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1850.

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands and improvements within the Municipality of Burnaby and to dedicate the same for Park purposes.

WHEREAS the Lochdale Social Club are the owners in fee simple of the lands and premises hereinafter described

AND WHEREAS the value of the said lands and premises does not exceed Two Thousand Dollars

AND WHEREAS the said Lochdale Social Club has offered to convey the said lands and premises to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby for Park purposes for the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred dollars (\$1700.00)

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient that the said lands and improvements thereon should be acquired for Park purposes

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That Lot Eleven, save and except East five (5') feet, of Subdivision Six (6) of Block Four (4) of subdivision of District Lot Two hundred and Six (206), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1323 in the Municipality of Burnaby and Province of British Columbia be acquired from the Lochdale Social Club for Park purposes.
2. That upon execution and delivery of Conveyance by the said Lochdale Social Club of the said Lot Eleven save and except East Five (5') feet, they shall be paid the sum of Seventeen Hundred (\$1700.00) dollars.
3. There is hereby defined and set apart for Park purposes all of the lands comprised in Lot Eleven (11) save and except the East Five (5') feet, of subdivision Six (6) of Block Four (4) of subdivision of District Lot Two hundred and Six (206), Group One (1), Map No. 1323 New Westminster District.

4. This By-law shall come into effect on the date of registration thereof.

5. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION AND PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW 1944."
