

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1864.

A BY-LAW RESPECTING SEWERS



WHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby has constructed or acquired certain public sewers in the Municipality of Burnaby and may from time to time construct or acquire sewers to be known and described as "public sewers".

AND WHEREAS the Corporation has powers under Subsection 200 of said Section 59 for charging against and collecting from any owner, lessee or occupier of a house, a rent or payment of money for the use of the public sewers:

AND WHEREAS the Corporation has powers under Section 247 of the said Municipal Act to levy and collect such sewer rental in the same manner as taxes as provided for under Sections 257 to 259, 265, and 270 to 290 of the said Municipal Act:

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, THEREFORE ENACTS as follows:

1. In this By-law, "public sewer" means a sewer acquired or constructed by the Corporation as distinguished from a sewer constructed under the "Local Improvement Act".
2. The sewers in District Lot 186 acquired by the Corporation through arbitration shall not be deemed to be a "public sewer" within the meaning of this By-law until it becomes necessary to reconstruct or replace the same or any portion thereof.
3. Every owner, lessee or occupier of a house in the Municipality who has connecting pipes from such property or properties to the public sewer shall pay a rent or payment of money for the use of the said public sewer of Fifteen (\$15.00) dollars per annum for each connection from the date on which such connection is made whether the owner, lessee or occupier connects thereto and/or uses the same or not, for a period of Twenty years and the said rent or payment of money shall become due and payable on the First day of January of each and every year during the said period.
4. By-law No. 828 shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

5. AND this By-law shall take effect upon the day and date of registration hereof.

6. THIS BY-LAW may be cited as "BURNABY SEWER RENTAL BY-LAW 1945."
