

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1878

A BY-LAW to define and set aside certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Park purposes.

WHEREAS by Paragraph (d) of subsection 179 of Section 59 of the "Municipal Act" it is provided that in every Municipality the Council may, by by-law finally passed by a three-fourths vote of all the members thereof, and without obtaining the assent of the electors, define an area comprising lands that have become the property of the Municipality through tax sale proceedings and set aside such area for park purposes, for recreation grounds, or school sites, or for other public purposes.

AND WHEREAS lands described as the Part nine decimal ninety (9.90) acres more or less of Block "J" of Lot One hundred and fifty (150), Group One (1), Map No. 6977 as shown outlined red on sketch 9455 in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, in the District of New Westminster became the property of the Corporation under the provisions of Paragraph (c) of said sub-section 179 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" and are deemed to be lands acquired by the Municipality under Tax Sale proceedings.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient and in the public interest that the said lands in the Municipality of Burnaby should be so set aside.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. There is hereby defined and set apart for park purposes all of the lands and premises situate lying and being in the Province of British Columbia, in the Municipality of Burnaby and being more particularly described as

Part nine decimal ninety (9.90) acres, more or less of Block "J" of Lot One hundred and Fifty (150), Group One (1), Map No. Six thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven (6977) as shown outlined red on Sketch nine thousand four hundred and fifty-five (9455) in the District of New Westminster.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW 1945".
