THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 1882.

A BY-LAW to define and set aside certain lands within the Municipality of Burnaby for Park purposes.

WHEREAS by paragraph (d) of sub-section 179 of Section 59 of the "Municipal Act" it is provided that in every Municipality the Council may, by By-law finally passed by a three fourths vote of all the members thereof, and without obtaining the assent of the electors, define an area comprising lands that have become the property of the Municipality through tax sale proceedings and set aside such area for park purposes, for recreation grounds, or school sites, or for other public purposes.

AND WHEREAS lands described as All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Province of British Columbia, Municipality of Burnaby and being more particularly described as the South part (Four decimal eighteen (4118) acres more or less of Block Twenty three (23) of Lots One hundred and Fifty-two (152) and One hundred and Fifty-three (153), Group One (1), Map Seven hundred and eighty-three (783) as shown and outlined red on Sketch deposited No. One thousand six hundred and thirty-nine (1639) in the District of New Westminster, became the property of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby under the provisions of paragraph (2) of Section 273 of the Municipal Act:

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient and in the public interest that the said lands in the Municipality of Burnaby should be so set aside for park purposes:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. There is hereby defined and set apart for park purposes all of the lands and premises situate lying and being in the Province of British Columbia, in the Municipality of Eurnaby and being more particularly described as

The South part (Four decimal eighteen (4.18) acres more or less of Block Twenty three (23) of Lots One hundred and fifty-two (152) and One hundred and fifty-three (153), Group One (1), Map Seven hundred and eighty-three (783) as shown and outlined Red

on Sketch deposited No. One thousand six hundred and thirtynine (1639) in the District of New Westminster save and except the South thirty-three (338) feet.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW No. 2, 1945".

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Twenty-fourth (24th) day of September, A.D. 1945

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by a three-fourths vote of all the members of the Municipal Council on the Ninth (9th) day of October, A.D. 1945
