

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1887

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire certain property within the Municipality of Burnaby and to dedicate the same for highway purposes.

WHEREAS lands and premises described as Lot Twenty (20) of Block Twenty (20) of District Lot Twenty nine (29), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 3035, is owned by George Evans McWilliam and Alice Vivian McWilliam.

AND WHEREAS the North thirty three (33) feet of the said Lot Twenty (20) is required by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, for the purpose of providing a road allowance for 16th Avenue between Douglas Road and Mary Avenue.

AND WHEREAS the said George Evans McWilliam and Alice Vivian McWilliam have agreed to convey the said north thirty-three (33) feet to the Corporation for the sum of \$325.00

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deem it advisable to acquire the said lands and to dedicate the same for highway purposes:

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Corporation and the Corporation is hereby authorized to accept from the said George Evans McWilliam and Alice Vivian McWilliam a conveyance or other form of transfer of the lands and premises described as ALL AND SINGULAR, that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being a portion of Lot 20, of Block 20, of Lot 29, Group 1, District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Plan No. 3035, deposited, and being more particularly described as follows: COMMENCING at the most westerly corner of Lot 20, aforesaid; thence North $50^{\circ} 57'$ East and following the Northwesterly boundary of said Lot 20, 164.9 feet to the most Northerly corner thereof; thence South $40^{\circ} 44'$ East and following the Northeasterly boundary of said Lot 20, 33.01 feet; thence South $50^{\circ} 57'$ West and parallel to the Northwesterly boundary of said Lot 20, 166.72 feet to a point on the Southwesterly boundary thereof; thence North $37^{\circ} 34'$ West and following the said Southwesterly boundary 33.01 feet to the point of commencement and containing, by

estimation 0.125 of an acre, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined with Red Colour.

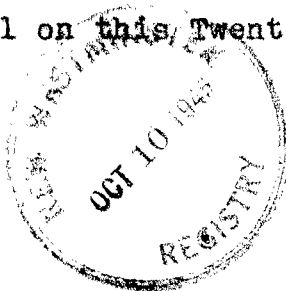
2. That on execution and delivery of conveyance, or other form of transfer, by the said George Evans McWilliam and Alice Vivian McWilliam, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby of the said lands, they shall be paid the sum of \$325.00

3. The said lands as shown outlined Red on Sketch hereto annexed, shall be and is hereby dedicated for street purposes.

4. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION AND STREET DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1945."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Twenty-fourth (24th) day of September, A.D. 1945.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by a three-fourths majority of the Municipal Council on this Twenty-sixth (26th) day of September, A.D. 1945.
